  - *Location:* Sport Center (121 E. Sunset Rd, Las Vegas, NV 89119)
  - 700 ASAS children will be invited to attend this event where they will be able to participate in several different rides and activities, including Go-Karts, Rock Climbing Wall, Batting Cages, Basketball, Football, Velcro Wall, Trackless Train and much more!
  - Volunteers will be needed to help monitor the rides and activity stations and ensure that all students are safe and having a great time.
- **12<sup>th</sup> Annual All-Star Showcase event – May 19, 2016** (2:00-7:00 p.m.)
  - *Location:* Springs Preserve (333 S Valley View Blvd, Las Vegas, NV 89107)
  - More than 700 ASAS students will attend this culminating event to showcase their skills learned in ASAS during the school year.
  - Student groups will be performing on stage at the Springs Preserve Amphitheater (e.g. Hip-Hop Dance, Ballet Folklorico, Mariachi, Choir, etc.).
  - Volunteers will be needed to help setup for the event (between 2:00-4:00pm) and during the event to escort students to their section (between 4:30-7:30pm)

- **Lifetime Adventures program** – various dates
  - Locations: vary but include Red Rock Canyon, Lake Mead, etc.
  - Students in the Lifetime Adventures program learn take hikes, day trips and camping experiences to various locations. They learn about environmental stewardship, protecting the environment, no trace left behind and much more.
