Communities in Schools (CIS)

CIS, in collaboration with The Public Education Foundation and Spread the Word Nevada, partnered with a host of community donors to assemble and deliver 10,000 kits to CCSD students who attend high-poverty schools throughout Southern Nevada in an initiative known as *Direct Care to Kids*. Its goal is to help meet basic immediate needs relative to personal hygiene and prevent students from falling further behind academically by providing books and educational materials to allow them the opportunity to continue learning from home during the COVID-19 pandemic while schools are closed.
