Volunteering

Boys Town Nevada relies on volunteer groups to help with projects throughout the year. Volunteers help to provide basic necessities for youth and families, prepare youth for success after Boys Town, and bring joy to our clients during the holidays and throughout the year. Some specific programs we've held in the past are:

- Career Day – 1 hour presentation and Q&A to youth in the Family Homes Program about your career pathway. We hold these one time a month on Saturday mornings.
- Teach a transition to adulthood class – Transition to Adulthood is our independent living skills classes for the youth in our Family Homes Program. Topics can include – self-care, budgeting, housing options, nutrition, education, resume building, job interview practices, etc. These are also held one time a month on a Saturday morning for an hour.
- Cook and eat with one of the Family Homes – Bring the ingredients, cook dinner with the kids, sit down and eat with one of the homes (boys or girls).
- Sponsor a summer rec camp activity – Throughout the summer months, groups can sponsor/host an activity for the youth on campus. Ideas include at the movies, a pool, or at a park.
