**Nevada Women's Philanthropy grants \$490,000 to Lutheran Social Services  
A \$30,000 NWP Founders Gift was awarded to Bridge Counseling**

Las Vegas (May 28, 2019) – Nevada Women's Philanthropy (NWP) elected to grant \$490,000 to Lutheran Social Services of Nevada (LSSN) to help bolster food bank services on its Boulder Highway Collaborative Campus. The NWP Founders Gift for \$30,000 was awarded to Bridge Counseling.

"LSSN is a dedicated, innovative, creative organization that is effectively tackling many of the issues facing our community's homeless and lower-income populations," said NWP President Cindy Ellis. We are delighted to welcome them to the NWP Family."

The NWP Impact Grant will primarily be used to build an additional 2,000 square feet to expand the current 750-square-foot DigiMart™ Food Pantry at its Boulder Highway campus. The addition will allow it to serve an additional 5,000 food-insecure individuals annually.

"It has been a dream of mine for a long time to build a one-stop-shop where people in our community can come and get the assistance they need all in one place," said Armena Mnatsakanyan, Executive Director at LSSN. "The expansion was the final piece of the puzzle."
