Volunteer Opportunities

The following are volunteer opportunities that we have:

Home Care Volunteers – Sitting with a patient in their home so their caregiver can leave the home to run errands or simply to provide socialization or emotional support for the patient or caregiver.

Nursing Home – Volunteer with patients residing in nursing homes or group homes.

Spiritual Support – Chaplain Volunteers provide spiritual support and assist with events as appropriate.

Bereavement Services – Assist the Bereavement department with calls or in other areas as needed.

Support Staff – Clerical support, data entry, filing, front desk support, help with phones and incoming office traffic.

Event Support – Help with mailers, event set up, take downs and support.

Meal Delivery Drivers – Every other Friday we need help with meal pick up and deliveries.

Next Training Dates: June 21 and 23. 6/21 from 5:30 pm to 8 pm and Saturday, 6/23 from 9 am to 5 pm. Both days are required. If someone is anxious to start volunteering we can get them started with paperwork and background check and they can attend Saturday only in September.
